


# HOW THIS „AT LEAST ONE 3-HIT“ GUARANTEE IS ACHIEVED?

How is this „AT LEAST ONE 3-HIT“-guarantee is achieved?

This brief guide explains how to play a combined system made of two VEW 622 systems plus 22 extra lines on one system slip (two VEW 622) and two normal slips. It also explains why this system is truly 100% safe regarding the promise "at least one 3-hit" and how you can assemble such systems yourself.

## 1. Split all 49 Lotto numbers into 3 groups:



- Put the first 22 system numbers (any numbers you like; if creating your own mapping, use a table such as "System number 1 -> actual number X, etc.) into the VEW 622 system (VEW = "Verkürzte engere Wahl"). The checkmark rollout scheme for VEW 622 is available from us and in VEW brochures; this yields 77 lines. Do exactly the same with system numbers 23--44 into a second VEW 622. That yields another 77 lines. Total used so far: 77 + 77 = 154 lines. From 176 total lines, 22 lines remain. Fill these remaining 22 lines on the normal slips with the five identical system numbers 45--49 from Group 3. As the sixth number for each of the 22 tips, use, in sequence, the system numbers 23--44 (from Group 2).

## 3. Now consider all possible situations of the 6 winning numbers:

<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At least 3 of the winning numbers are in Group 1</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>VEW 622 lottery wheel guarantees exactly one 3-hit when you have 3 correct numbers within its 22-number field. Thus, the first VEW 622 ensures the guarantee. With more than 3 winning numbers in Group 1, consult the VEW 622 system properties (or use our win-check program MELM).</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At least 3 of the winning numbers are in Group 2</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>Analogous: the second VEW 622 guarantees one 3-hit when 3 are correct within its 22-number field.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>A rare but also covered case: exactly 2 winning numbers in each group (2 in Group 1, etc.)</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>We secured this variant by filling Group 3 lines with the fixed five numbers (45--49) and combining them with the sequential sixth numbers from Group 2 (23--44). The 2 winners from Group 3 are thereby paired across all Group 2 numbers, producing exactly two 3-hits.</li> </ul>
<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>At least 3 of the winning numbers are in Group 3</li> </ul>	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> <li>This is practically the best option: the 22 normal lines each contain the same five Group 3 numbers, so you achieve at least 22 three-hits when group 3 holds 3 winner numbers.</li> </ul>

If you have the time, you can use the tick-rollout (in German: "Kreuzchen-Abrollschema") of VEW 622 together with this explanation to assemble this 176-line system to your liking. The system is built upon the guarantee property of VEW 622 for 22-number selections, plus the targeted pairing of Group 3 and Group 2 numbers for the mixed 2-2-2 case.
